Payment: The \$40 non-refundable non-transferable deposit is a minimum payment. You may pay in full at time of registration or return to make additional payments.

STATUS: Enrolled vs. Registered

ENROLLED: Information is entered, but no payment is made; space is not held.

REGISTERED: Minimum \$40 non-refundable deposit is paid; space is held.

Cancellations Prior to Camp: The \$40 non-refundable deposit is deducted and remaining balance refunded. No refunds made for campers who leave during the week.

Spending Money: Pre-pay through online registration or "deposit" cash upon arrival; unused funds are refunded to camper in cash at the end of the week.

VISITS: We recommend that parents refrain from visiting or calling during camp. Experience has shown that this often promotes homesickness for your child and others. Camps are not open to the general public, including evening services. Only registered campers & staff are allowed on grounds. For necessary visits, please call first.

EMAIL—ONE-WAY PLAN: A **FREE** one-way email plan can be accessed on your Dashboard in online registration. There is a one-day delay, i.e. messages sent on Mon are received on Tues.

MEDICATIONS: Update online health and medication details before arrival if necessary or send a printed list of changes with parent signature and date. Upon arrival bring all meds to the nurse in a plastic zip bag and in original container/label including: 1-camper name 2-doctor name 3-prescription number 4-date prescribed 5-medication name 6-dosing. *It is camper's responsibility to go to the nurse for meds.*

HOUSING: Cabin partner requests may be made online. Housing and color team assignments will be released in the week prior to each camp. Remember, campers need to bring their own pillow, sleeping bag or bedding, towels, and soap—see packing list.

SPENDING MONEY: The Snack Stand is open during free time and there is a small camp store in the camp office. *We recommend campers deposit their spending money in the camp bank for safekeeping.*

INSURANCE: Registered campers are insured for *injury* incurred at camp, secondary to personal insurance. Camp insurance pays eligible medical expenses up to maximum benefits after benefits from other policies are exhausted. Illness at camp is not a covered expense.

MEALS: Salad bar available at noon and evening meals. The **Snack Stand** has hamburgers, hot dogs, ice cream and other snacks for sale. A menu is available upon request. Parents can help identify good choices and send along other items to supplement.

SPENDING MONEY: The Snack Stand is open during free time and there is a small store in the camp office. *We recommend campers deposit their spending money in the camp bank for safekeeping.*

LOST & FOUND: SLSC is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. It is the camper's responsibility to check in the office for lost items. **We strongly discourage bringing sentimental objects or items of value, electronic devices, sports equipment, etc.** Shipping will be charged for returned items. Lost and found is kept for one month.

DRESS POLICY: All campers are expected to dress modestly.

- Modest one-piece swimsuit required for girls or shirt covering
- No spaghetti straps or plunging necklines
- No hats or shirts with inappropriate imprints—i.e. alcohol/tobacco
- Shorts and skirts should be finger-tip length or longer

CAMP RULES

Lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude will result in expulsion from camp. Parents bear responsibility and expense to transport home.

1. Show consideration for others.
2. Attendance at classes, chapel, and evening service is required.
3. Room and grounds must be kept clean. *Churches and campers are responsible to pay for damage to their room.*
4. Robe or large towel must be worn to and from the beach. Shoes and shirts must be worn in dining hall and snack stand.
5. Campers must be in bed and quiet by "lights out".
6. Clothing must be modest. See "Dress Policy."
7. Campers may not enter another cabin without cabin leader's permission.
