2021 Wisconsin/N. Michigan District Categories

Again, this year we are going to have three District level categories that can be entered but NOT sent to the National Fine Arts.

1. Cake Decoration
2. Cookie Tasting
3. Cupcake Tasting

All baked goods will be auctioned off in a silent auction with proceeds benefiting Speed the Light.

BAKING DIVISION RULES

General Rules:

The same general rules of Fine Arts apply to these two categories including:

1. Age requirements
2. Participates in youth group
3. May not enter the same category of the division twice

(Details of these rules can be found in the Fine Arts Festival Rule book pg 10-16)

Rules Specific to Wisconsin/Northern Michigan District are as follows:

1. COOKIES/CUPCAKES TASTING

- There must be **27** cookies/ **15** cupcakes in an entry. **3** of these must be on a separate plate for our evaluators.
- The cookies/cupcakes can be any type or flavor that you would like and will be judged based on taste, originality, appearance, and presentation/plating.
- Entries must include a recipe card for the evaluators.
- Entries must be in a container or on a tray that you **DO NOT WANT BACK.**
- All entries must be in 10 minutes before Orientation begins.

2. CAKE DECORATING

- The cake can be either round or square.
- Round cakes can be no bigger than 10" round and three layers thick. (Not including the decorations on the top)
- Sheet cakes can be no bigger than 9"x 13" and three layers thick. (Not including the decorations on the top)
- There is no longer a theme for Fine Arts so you can decorate your cake however you would like.
- The cake will be judged based on originality and over all appearance. All decorations must be edible.
- Decorated cakes must be out of pan and on a tray that you **DO NOT WANT BACK.**
- All cakes must be in 10 minutes before Orientation begins.

2021 Wisconsin/N. Michigan Fine Arts Frequently Asked Questions



Q. What is the theme for 2021 Fine Arts this year?

A. There is no theme for Fine Arts. All presentations must have a clear Christian message, possess obvious redemptive value, and be presented with ministry effectiveness in mind.

Q. What is the Rulebook and how do I get one?

A. The 2021 Fine Arts Festival Rulebook comes from the National Fine Arts office and contains detailed information about each category, such as rules/guidelines for that specific division and information about how you will be judged. Each participant is responsible to read and agree to abide by the rules listed in the Rulebook. You can download it at www.youth.ag.org/Participate/Fine-Arts or www.studentmin.com/fine-arts. Be sure to read the general information & general rules) as well as Division and Category rules.

Q. How do I register?

A. Each participant must fill out a Participant Registration Form and give it to your church's FAF Coordinator well in advance of the deadline. (Your FAF Coordinator needs time to prepare the group forms and mail the church forms and fees together in one packet before the deadline. The church FAF Coordinator must fill out one form that lists all the groups and names of individuals in each group.) All fees are **non-refundable**.

Q. Who do I ask questions?

A. All questions can be directed to finearts@studentmin.com.

Q. What equipment is provided?

A. CHRISTIAN BAND, SONGWRITING and WORSHIP TEAM—The following will be provided: 2 guitar amps, 1 bass guitar amp, 1 piano, CD player, 1 basic drum set, 8 microphones, and 2 floor monitors.

YOUTH CHOIR— Equipment provided for youth choir is the same as for Christian Band and Worship Team.

Microphones will only be used for Worship Team and Christian Band, and only solo microphones for Choir. Indicate any "vocalist" or "soloist".

PUPPETRY entries should be prepared to provide their own puppet stage (Confirm with the Student Ministries office).

For specific requests or questions about provided equipment, please contact our office.

Q. What about Copyrighted Materials?

A. Be sure to follow the "Copyrighted Material" section on page 23 of the Rulebook.

Q. Will I know my scheduled times before the Festival day?

A. The Church FAF Coordinator or youth pastor will receive a confirmation and individual performance schedule at least two weeks before the Festival.

Q. How do I check in the day of the festival?

A. Upon arrival at the festival, **one responsible person from each church (FAF coordinator)** will check in all participants. He/she will be asked to note any emergency substitutions, and alert the registrar of any participants withdrawing from the festival and/or canceling a performance. He/she will then be given a registration packet for the group.

Q. When and how are Writing Entries and Short Film entries to be submitted??

A. All pre-evaluated categories should be submitted by April 12, 2020. Writing entries must be submitted in .doc, .docx or .pdf format and attached to the email. Short Film entries must be uploaded to Vimeo or YouTube and submitted by emailing a link to finearts@studentmin.com. All entries must be emailed to finearts@studentmin.com with a subject line that contains participant's name and "2021 (Category) Entry". Any questions can be directed to finearts@studentmin.com

Q. How will I know my rating and if I am eligible to advance to Nationals?

A. **All certificates will be given out in the final moments of the Festival. Your FAF leader will pick up all certificates for participants from your church at the closing of the Encore - about 3:00 pm.** Entries/presentations which receive a **SUPERIOR WITH INVITATION or Advance** at the District Fine Arts Festival, are eligible to enter the National Fine Arts Festival in Columbus Ohio August 3-August 7, 2021. Q. What should I bring to the District Festival?

A. Accompaniment tracks must be in .mp3 format and playable through an auxiliary cord(Headphone jax). To be prepared, bring a boom box/CD player for you or your students to rehearse with, original and copies of music, scripts, modest dress clothes and shoes, a watch, and money for food.
